

## Moving Your Pets

### Basic Checklist for Your Pet

Please note that this list does not include all pets' needs. Contact your veterinarian for professional advice.

GATHER	COMPLETED (Add date or checkmark)
Veterinary records, certificates, and recent photos	
Medications	
Your pets' usual foods and plenty of water from the home you're leaving (changing their water source can be disorienting and upset)	
Food and water bowls, a can opener, and resealable lids	
Toys, chew bones, and treats	
Leashes for cats and dogs	
Beds (pillows, towels, crate liners, or other crate liner materials)	
Plastic bags and scoops for dogs	
Litter box for cats	
Cage covers for birds or rodents	
Reptilian supplies, heat rocks, lamps, food, water sources, etc.	
Paper towels and cleaner for messes	
Provisions for the first day at the new home
