

## **President Elect of the Board**

It shall be the responsibility of the President Elect to assist the President and to represent the Association in whatever capacity is designated by the President. During the second year of the President Elects two-year term he/she undertakes the full responsibilities of the office of Association President. The President Elect shall also represent the Association as a director of the CONNECTICUT ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS®; this appointment shall reduce our CAR elected allotment by one seat (1) yearly. The President Elect shall have full voting rights as a member of The Board of Directors. However, the president elect does not automatically become president of the board if the current president can no longer serve his/her term.

This means, that the president elect must be close to the activities of the current president, learning the duties of the president and preparing to assume that job.

Like all officers of the board, the president elect has no authority to speak or act on behalf of the board other than the authority specifically granted in the bylaws, in board policy or by majority vote of the board of directors.

In addition to preparing to become president, the president elect...

- manages special assignments as requested by the president,
- serves on the Executive Committee.

**All officer positions require a commitment of extra time and responsibility. Board members who cannot make this extra commitment should not seek or accept this office.**
